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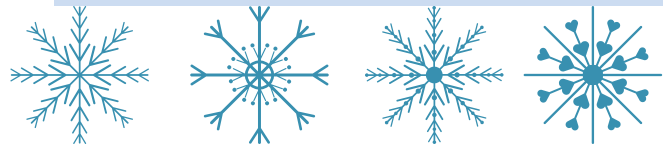

Shorts: September, May and June.

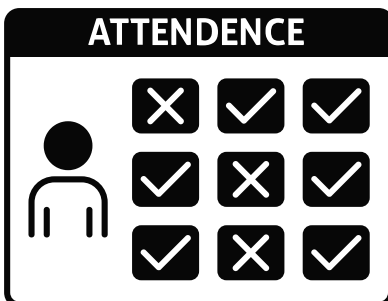
Grades 4K-3- snow suit or pants and a jacket, gloves or mittens, hats and boots.

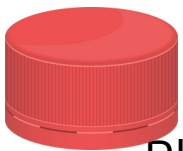

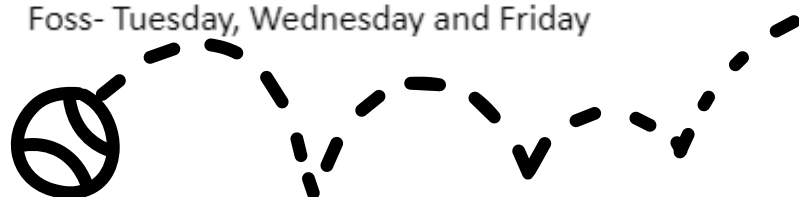

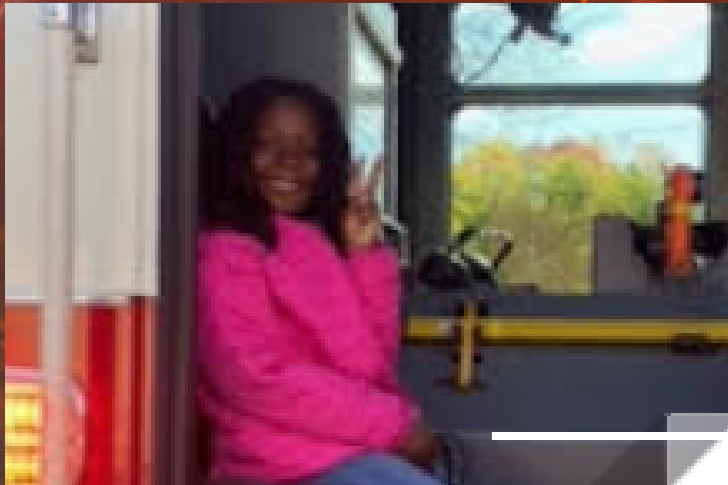

Clovis Parking, Drop-off, and Pick-up

For the safety of our children.....

There is NO drop off, pick up or parking in Clovis parking lots.

The only families that should be coming in the parking lot are those families that have a meeting with a staff member or those who are getting out of their vehicles and will need handicapped parking.

Please look at the reverse side of this paper for a map that explains where you can and cannot park.

Dropping off by personal vehicle in the AM:


- Students should be dropped off no earlier than 8:15am. Students enter the following doors:
 - 4K-door 2
 - Kindergarten-door 3
 - Grade 1-Front doors (door 1)
 - Grade 2-door 9
 - Grade 3-door 11
 - Grade 4-door 10
 - Grade 5-door 9
- Older siblings may assist younger siblings get to their appropriate entry door

Picking up by personal vehicle in the PM:

- Students will be dismissed from school according to the following schedule:
 - 3:25-Grade 2-door 9
 - 3:27-Grade 3-door 11
 - 3:29-Grade 4-door 10
 - 3:30-Grades 1 (door 11) and grade 5 (door 9)
 - 4K and Kindergarten parents will receive dismissal information from the classroom teachers.
- Older siblings may meet their younger siblings at the door that the younger sibling exits.
