

Just a gentle reminder that as the weather gets colder, the school doors do not open until 8:20 am. Please make sure your children are dressed appropriately for the weather. Students go outside for recess if it is zero degrees (0 degrees wind chill) or above.

Grade 4K-3 - snowsuit or snow pants and jacket, gloves or mittens, hat and boots.

Grade 4-5 - jacket, gloves or mittens, hats and boots (snowsuit or pants if they plan to be on the playground or in the snow).

If students do not have boots and snow pants, they MUST stay on the blacktop!

Too Sick for School??

Fever: If temperature if 100F or greater. Must be fever free, without fever reducing medication, for 24 hours before returning.

Vomiting: Until vomiting stops for 24 hours.

Pink Eye: Until drainage is no longer present and fever-free.

Strep Throat: Until 24 hours after antibiotic treatment and fever free.




Bridges Parent Newsletters
