Who are the NJHS Co-Chairs?

When and where does the ceremony take place:

The NJHS ceremony will take place on April 30, 2025 at 7:00PM. The location is Maplewood Middle School, in the gymnasium.

What time should the inductees arrive?

The inductees should arrive at 6:40pm, this is to ensure everyone is in the proper place and ready to go at 7:00pm sharp.

What should the inductees wear?

All Maplewood dress code regulations apply. This event is an honor and all students should dress appropriately; no holes in clothing, no inappropriate logos/graphics/or wording, no t-shirts, sweatshirts, yoga pants, shorts, etc...

Gentlemen ~ Khakis or nice blue jeans are appropriate. Button down shirts or collared shirts are appropriate. Ties and suit jackets are appropriate.

Young Ladies ~ Dresses, skirts, khakis and nice jeans are appropriate. Dress shirts, sweaters and blouses are appropriate.

Where do the guests sit?

The bleachers will be pulled out and chairs will be set up behind the inductees chairs for audience members.

There will also be reserved seating for the handicap.

Can inductees invite teachers/staff members?

Students can invite current and past teachers/staff members.

Can inductees invite extended family members?

Extended family members are welcome.

Are younger siblings allowed?

Younger siblings are welcome.

Are friends of an inductee invited?

Adult friends are invited. In addition if a family wishes to bring along a peer of their student they may do so and are responsible for their behavior.

Are the guests allowed to take pictures?

Yes, guests may take pictures.

Are the inductees allowed to have their cell phones with them during the ceremony?

Inductees are NOT allowed to have their cell phones with them during the ceremony.

Is there any type of fee associated with NJHS?

There is no fee.

How long will the ceremony last?

The ceremony will last approximately one hour.

Is there a reception following the ceremony?

There is a reception in the commons/cafeteria immediately following the ceremony.

Cookies and punch will be served.

The reception portion of the evening usually lasts about 30 - 45 minutes.
