

#### **Student Dress Guidelines**

The registration process typically takes just a few minutes during your first visit, as an office staff member will assist you in completing it. To save time, you may pre-register at the school office prior to your visit.

Counting practice supports students' growth in addition, subtraction, multiplication, and division of whole numbers, fractions, and decimals. Count forward; count backward. Count in the car, on a walk, while playing on the

swings. Count by multiples, fractions, decimals, and time intervals. And count on having fun!
