What's Happening Now at Maplewood School?

- Wall paneling on the building's north and northeast sides as well as on the athletic storage building is almost finished.
- Concrete apron to the receiving doors has been poured.
- Painting throughout the second floor is in progress.
- Terrazzo flooring is being installed.

What's Coming Next at Maplewood School?

- Installation of exterior electrical devices.
- Casework installation in classrooms.
- Completion of rooftop solar array.



Composite wall panel installation is nearing completion, and exterior electrical devices are beginning to be placed.



Curtain wall glazing and metal flashing installation is continuing on the south side of the building.

Construction Keywords Glossary

Curtain wall glazing: Glass that is used in an exterior, non-structural wall designed to protect a building from the elements.

Metal flashing: Thin, flexible sheet metal installed at critical points on a rooftop to act as a waterproof barrier.

MEP: Mechanical, electrical, and plumbing.
